- This entry represents the number of shares of Viasat, Inc. common stock withheld by the Issuer to satisfy the tax withholding obligation of the Reporting Person. These shares were not sold by the Reporting Person but were instead offset from the total number of vested shares received by the Reporting Person from the Issuer.
- Includes 279 shares of common stock the reporting person acquired under the Viasat 401(k) Plan, since the date of the reporting person's last ownership report.
- The original restricted stock grant was for 2,994 shares on 11/15/2019. Subject to the reporting person's continued employment with the Issuer, the units vest and convert into shares of common stock (on a 1-for-1 basis) in four (4) equal annual installments beginning on 11/17/2020.
- Until vested, the restricted stock unit shall be subject to forfeiture in the event of termination of employment or service with the Issuer.
- The original award was for 20,320 restricted stock units on 11/17/2020. Subject to the Reporting Person's continued employment with the Issuer, the units vest and convert into shares of common stock of the Issuer (on a 1-for-1 basis) in four (4) equal annual installments beginning on 11/17/2021.
- The original restricted stock grant was for 3,000 shares on 11/19/2018. Subject to the reporting person's continued employment with the Issuer, the units vest and convert into shares of common stock (on a 1-for-1 basis) in four (4) equal annual installments beginning on 11/19/2019.
